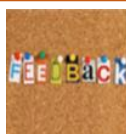
Coffee Morning

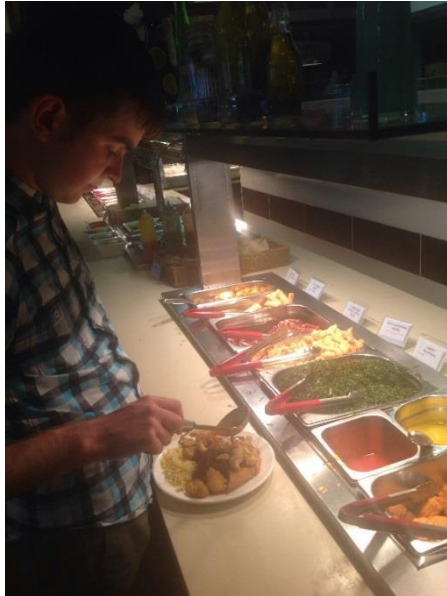

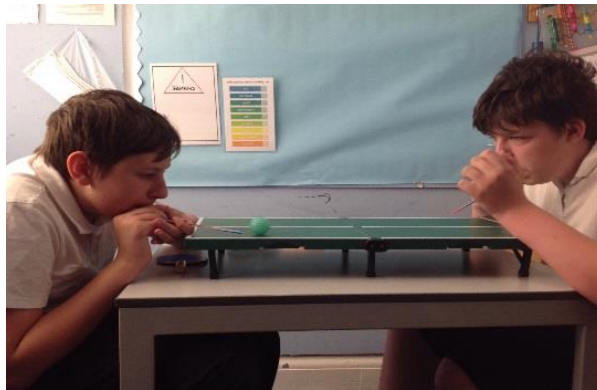

Therapy

We use a lot of different games in Occupational Therapy, which works on many skills. This includes fine motor skills, oral motor skills as well as teaching pupils to work in teams, take turns, make decisions and problem solve. It also helps pupils to learn emotional resilience which is part of the school's learning and thinking skills. Pupils learn rules of the games, sportsmanship (winning and losing) and how to resolve any conflicts appropriately. Pupils are encouraged to lead the activity and the therapist reinforces good behaviour and morals.

SHOW SUPPORT

The target is to encourage pupils to be supportive of their peers, through use of language and actions.

Facts re ASD

- Poor theory of mind makes it difficult for pupils to understand what and how others think and feel
- They cannot readily understand or predict the intentions of others
- They may be disinterested in other people and not understand the social value in helping their peers
- It is hard for them to recognise that others have their own plans, thoughts and points of view
- Pupils need to learn to use appropriate language to offer support and reinforcement to their peers

Suggested Script

- Please show support. See if you can help your partner to finish their work.
- Please show support and help Mrs. Xx to move the chairs.
- You could show support and listen to xx's answer.
- Thank you for helping me to carry these books. You have shown support

Hints and Tips

- Adults need to help pupils by describing a behaviour that merits support, such as 'It is kind to get a chair for x, thanks you for doing that. You have shown support'.
- 'That was a helpful thing to do'. 'You could say thank you to x for helping you with your work'.
- Adults can direct pupils' behaviour 'You could show support and help xx with ...'
