Dear Families

I hope you and your family are well and continue to stay safe during this unprecedented time.

I am writing to update you on the changes that will be taking place at St Dominic's School from the week beginning 6 July 2020.

The government's latest guidelines for recovery include a reduction in the two metre social distancing rule to one metre from 4 July 2020. As an OHC&AT special academy, we are following the guidance and implementing as appropriate for our individual setting.


From Monday, 6 July to Friday, 17 July, the school will return to operating the full, 5 day timetable for Years 3 to 10. The school day will commence at 9.30am and finish at 3.00pm for all pupils. The school term finishes for these pupils on Friday, 17 July. More information on timetables and curriculum will be sent to you in preparation for 6 July.

On Monday 20 and Tuesday 21 July, we will be welcoming our Year 11 pupils and Sixth Form students back into school for transition programmes and our Dominic Savio and Leavers' Assembly (date and times to follow).

St Dominic's School will closed for summer on Tuesday, 21 July.

The new academic year 2020-2021 begins for staff on Tuesday, 1 September with two INSET days. The start for pupils and students will be staggered, with Year 3, Year 7 and Sixth Form returning on Thursday, 3 September, as these groups have the highest number of pupils/students. Years 8, 9, 10 and 11 will return on Monday, 7 September and the remainder of Key Stage 2 on Wednesday, 9 September.
