


Masks at St Dominic's School

Do I have to wear a mask?

No. Pupils and students at St Dominic's School do not have to wear a mask at school by law. We would like pupils in year 7 and above to wear them but only if they feel comfortable.

Am I going to get into trouble for not wanting to wear a mask?

No. No one is going to make you wear a mask if you don't feel comfortable.

Can I wear a mask if I want to?

Yes, of course. Pupils and students of any age can wear a mask if it makes them feel more comfortable.



Will staff be wearing masks?

Yes, sometimes. In some parts of the school staff will be wearing masks. They will not be working with you in the classroom or other learning spaces with masks on but they will have them on when they are walking around school and serving lunch in the dining hall.

What do I do with my mask when I am not wearing it?

You need to put your mask in your bag or in your pocket and use gel on your hands when you have taken it off. If you can, store your mask in a plastic bag.
