Dear Families

I hope you had a restful weekend.

We have a very light update today as our current Covid-19 arrangements and risk assessment remain the same. I am pleased to report that there have been no further positive cases after the weekend, which is great news for our school community.

I would like to make you aware of a pupil and student facing change, and have attached for your attention a social story for pupil and student use about the wearing of personal protective equipment (PPE) by our nursing and healthcare team. They are integral to the running of the school and, in light of the recent positive cases, will now be wearing PPE more frequently around school and in surgery. We are aware that this may make some pupils and students feel anxious so we will be working with them on normalising this change. Pupils and students can expect to see Mrs Nesbit and Mrs Deans wearing medical scrubs at all times. They will also wear masks, as other staff do in internal communal spaces. When working with a pupil/student who is in the isolation room they will also wear a visor, gloves and an apron.

Please do talk to your child about this change. You may wish to use the social story to support your conversation, though some of our upper school pupils and students may not require the visual aid.
