We also have counsellors, therapeutic play practitioners, Emotional Literacy Support Workers and a range of primary and secondary trained teachers with a wealth of experience and knowledge in working with pupils and students with autism and associated language, communication and sensory needs.

For education settings

These packages are delivered virtually (or live if convenient) by a qualified therapist. There is an initial 2 hour session of direct training followed by a 'Problem Solving Session' once the training has been implemented.
